ST PETER'S HUBB SECURITY



If you have any concerns regarding your information being admitted to the St Peter's Hubb, please be reassured that your details are extremely safe and secure.

In relation to the electoral roll specifically, your information (Which you have already shared with us) has been kept in the cloud in recent years anyway, in our database. This was all on a spreadsheet on dropbox.

The <u>Hubb platform is much more secure</u> with very strict permissions, so that even the church staff and admin volunteers can only see what they need to.

The Hubb platform is designed to eliminate sharing of private data by email, which can easily result in copies of data being accidentally forwarded to incorrect addresses, and old copies of data sitting in insecure email accounts.

The Hubb platform is designed to eliminate paper copies of private data, which are easy to accidentally leave lying around.
